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5. Do you think it is important to be kind to animals? Explain.

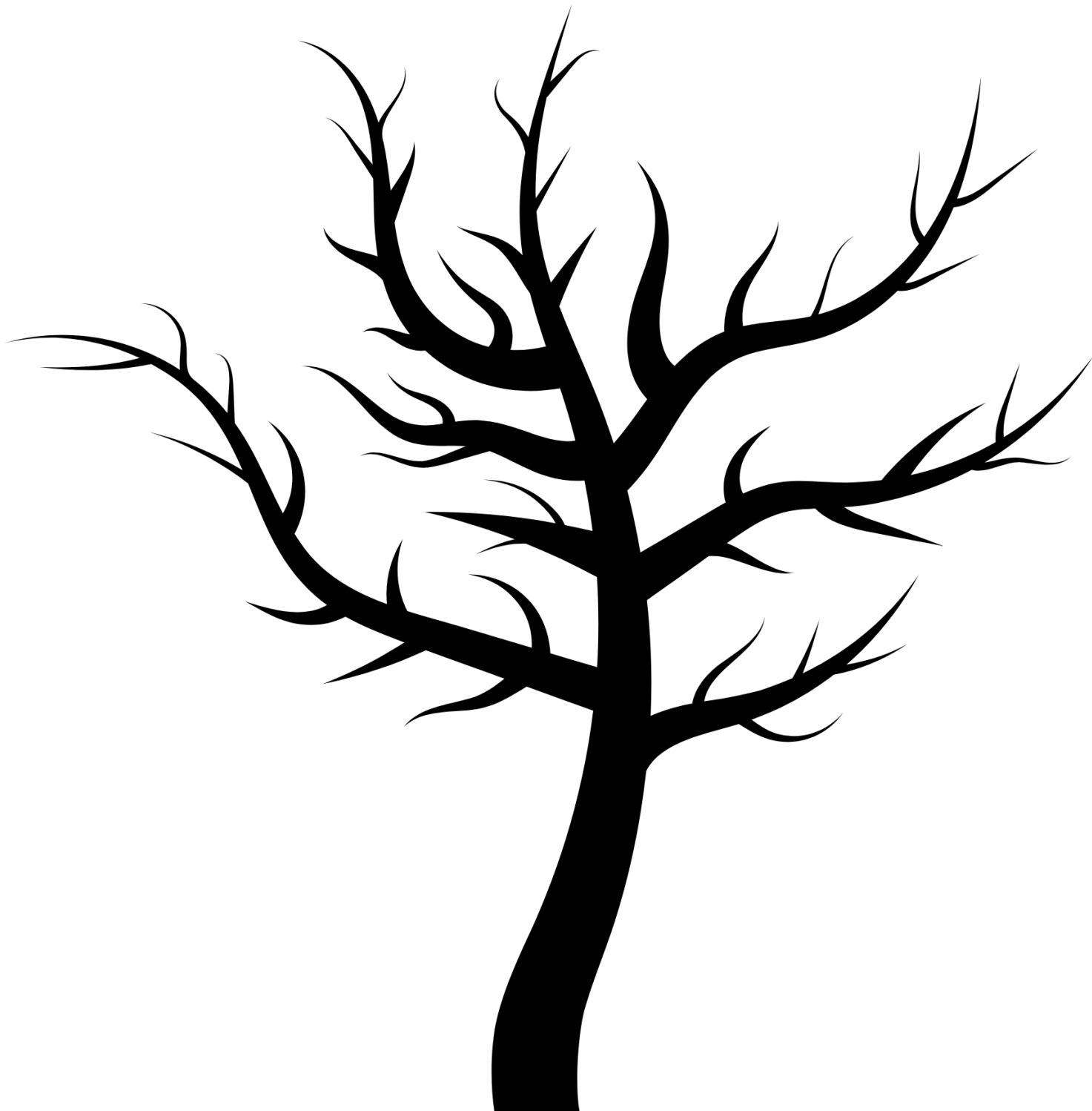
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# Kindness Tree Template
