# Coop Considerations Checklist

**Instructions:** Use the following checklist to help design a safe place for chickens to live.

	<b>roof</b>	Chickens need a roof to give them shelter from the elements.
	<b>walls</b>	Secure walls protect chickens from predators and the elements.
	<b>people door</b>	Access to all areas of the coop is necessary to keep the coop clean & tidy, and to collect the eggs.
	<b>chicken door</b>	A door that is big enough for chickens to enter and leave the coop.
	<b>food feeder</b>	A designated location for chickens to eat.
	<b>water source</b>	A designated location for chickens to access fresh, clean water.
	<b>fresh air</b>	A way for chickens to access fresh air. This can include vents or windows.
	<b>roost</b>	Chickens naturally perch on a roost to sleep. They feel safest while perching.
	<b>nesting box</b>	Hens like to lay eggs in a sheltered area. Nesting boxes are pre-made nests that hens can hide in to lay eggs.
	<b>secure outdoor space</b>	Be sure the outdoor space is surrounded by a secure fence to prevent predators from entering.
